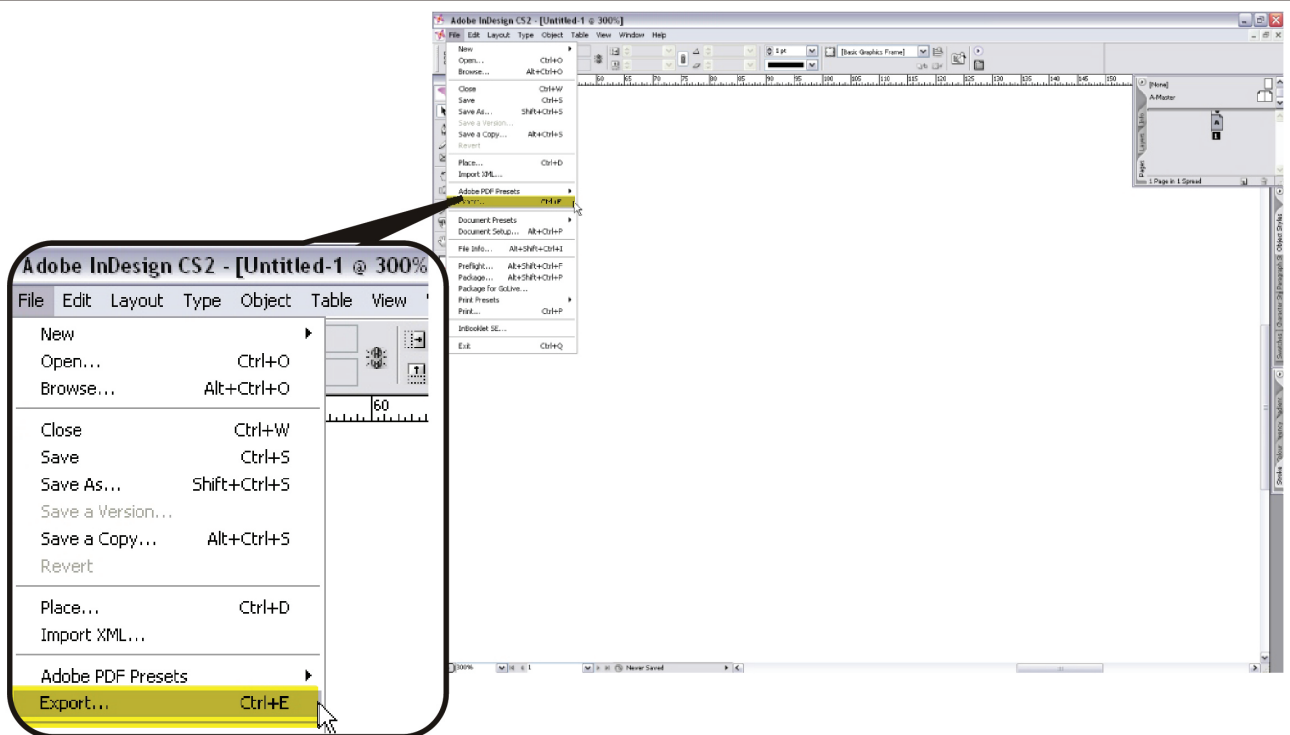
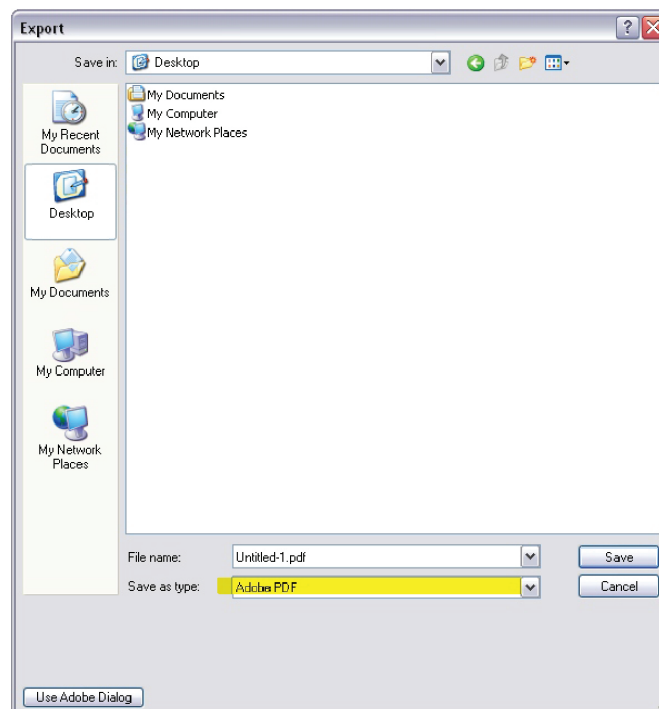


Step 01 - Export to PDF



To convert your final artwork to PDF, go to Menu bar > File > Export

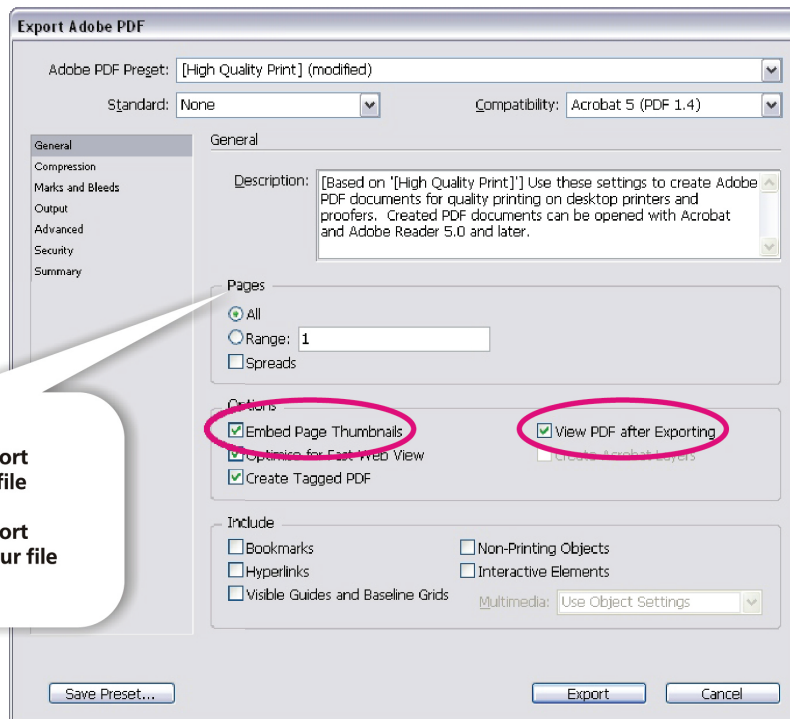
Step 02 - Choosing PDF Style



Save as Type > Choose **Adobe PDF (*.PDF)**

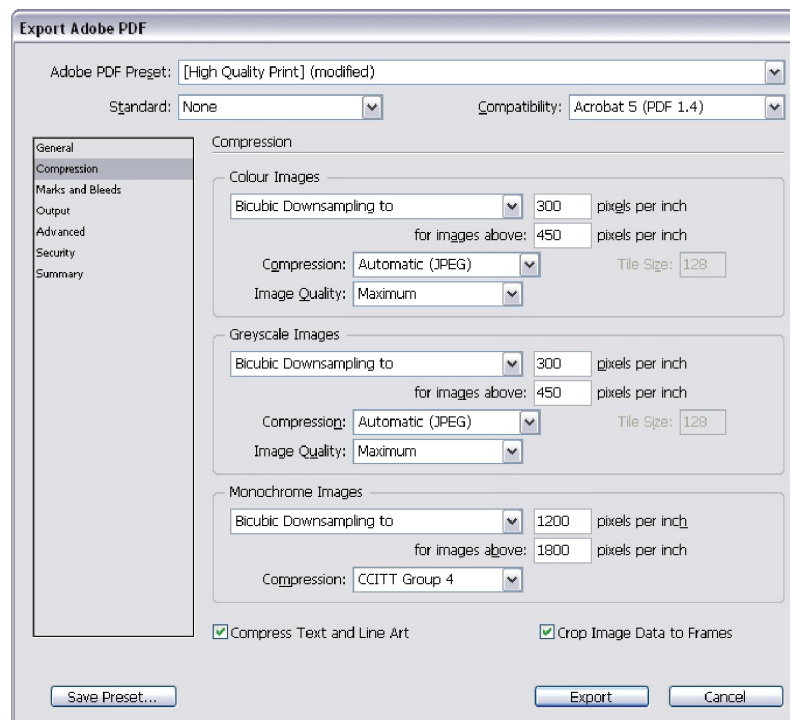
Click Save

Step 03 - General Setting



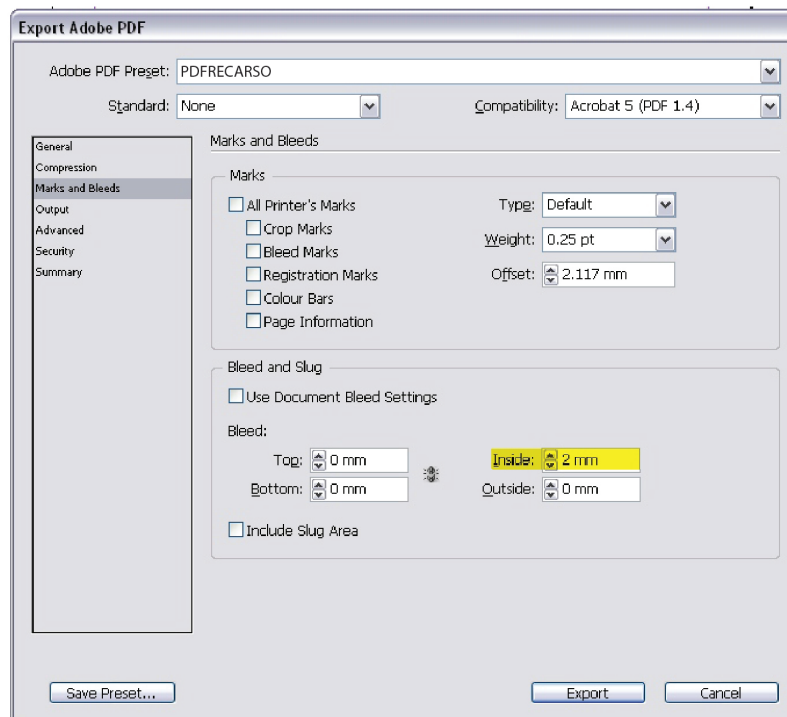
Follow the above setting

Step 05 - Marks and Bleeds Setting

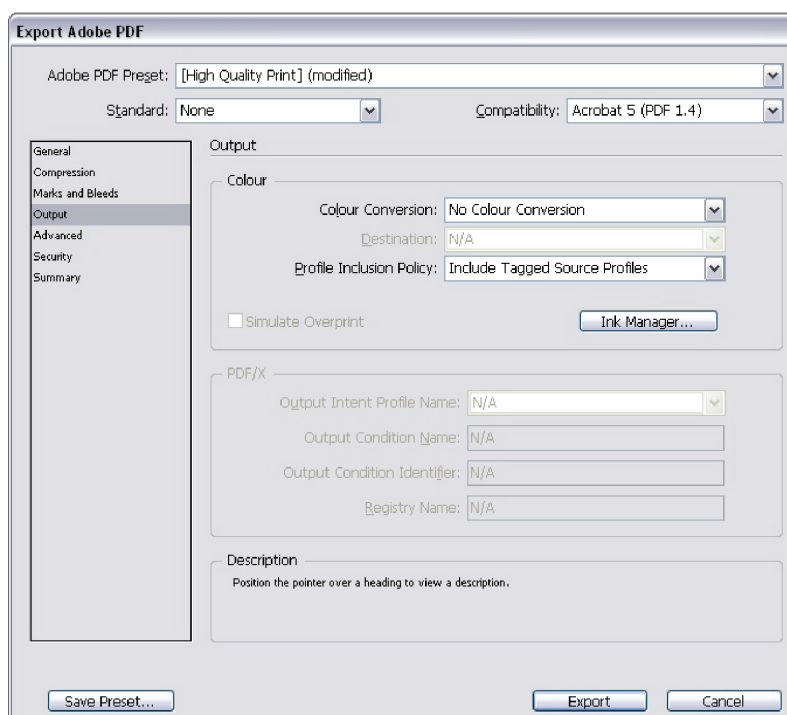


Change Inside Bleed to 2mm for Booklet design.

P/S: When designing for the rest of the products the Inside Bleed must remain 0mm.

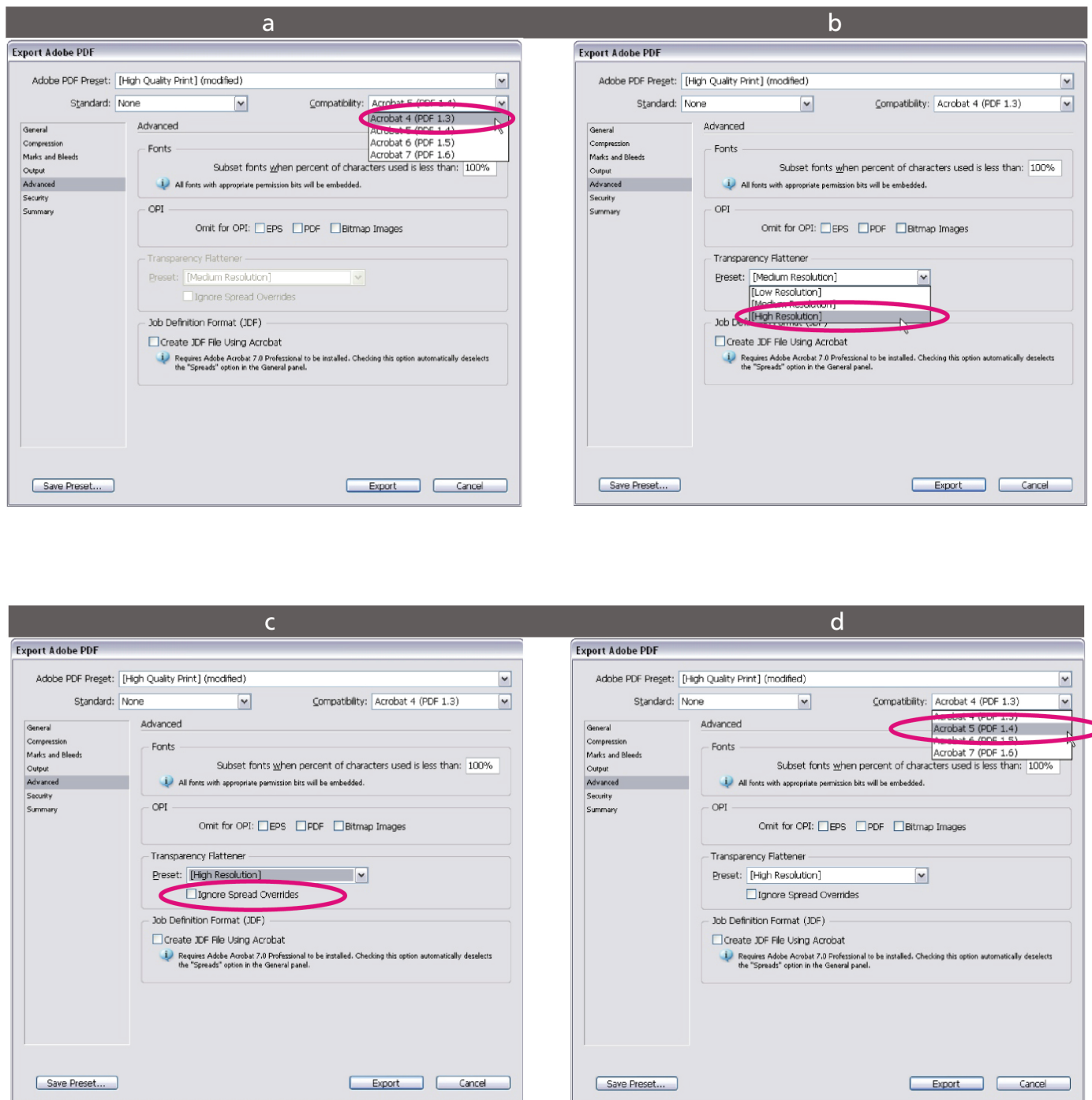
Important: For Booklet design using our product size template, you MUST change to the Inside Bleed to 2mm.

Step 06 - Output Setting

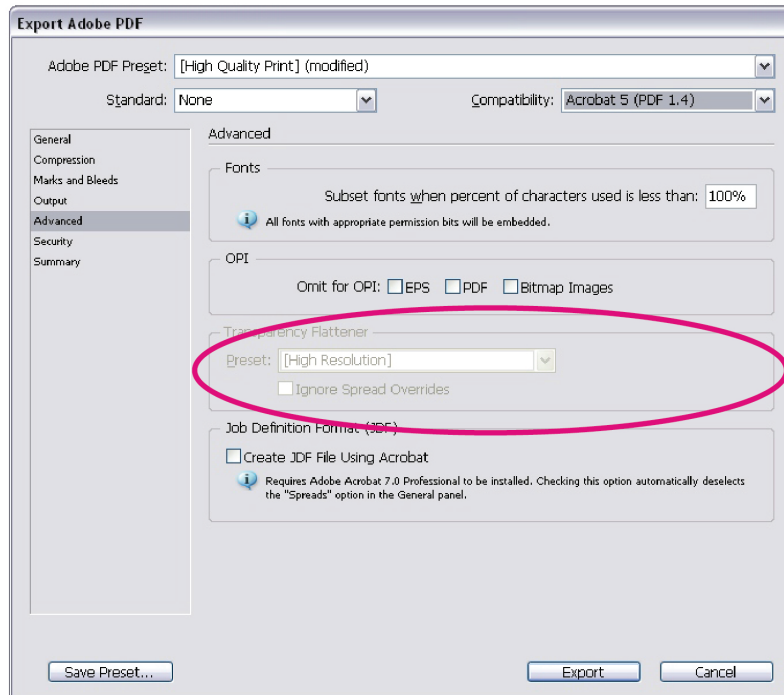

Step 07 - Advanced Setting

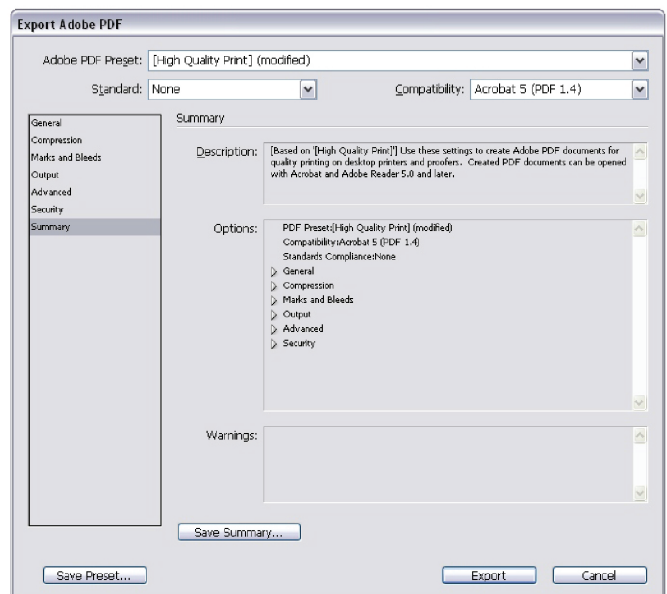
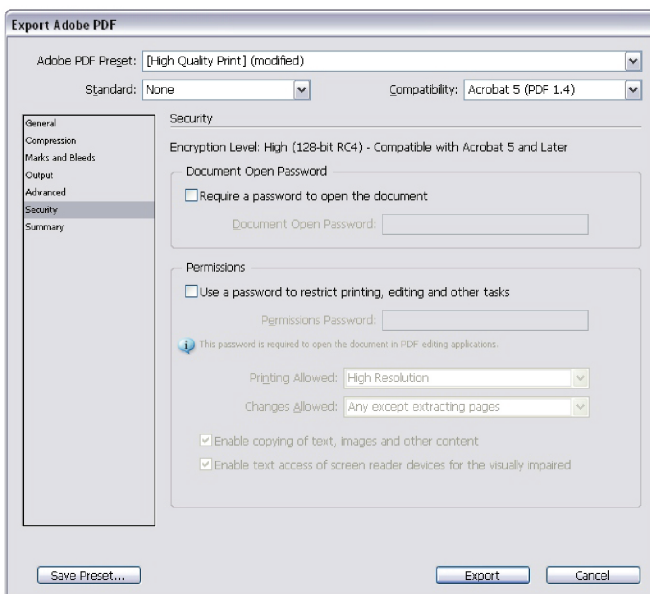


- a) Compatibility > Choose Acrobat 4 (PDF 1.3)
 b) Transparency Flattner > Preset > Ensure that it is set to **High Resolution**.
 c) Ensure 'Ignore Spread Override' is **UNCHECKED**
 d) Go back to Compatibility > Change it to **Acrobat 5 (PDF 1.4)**



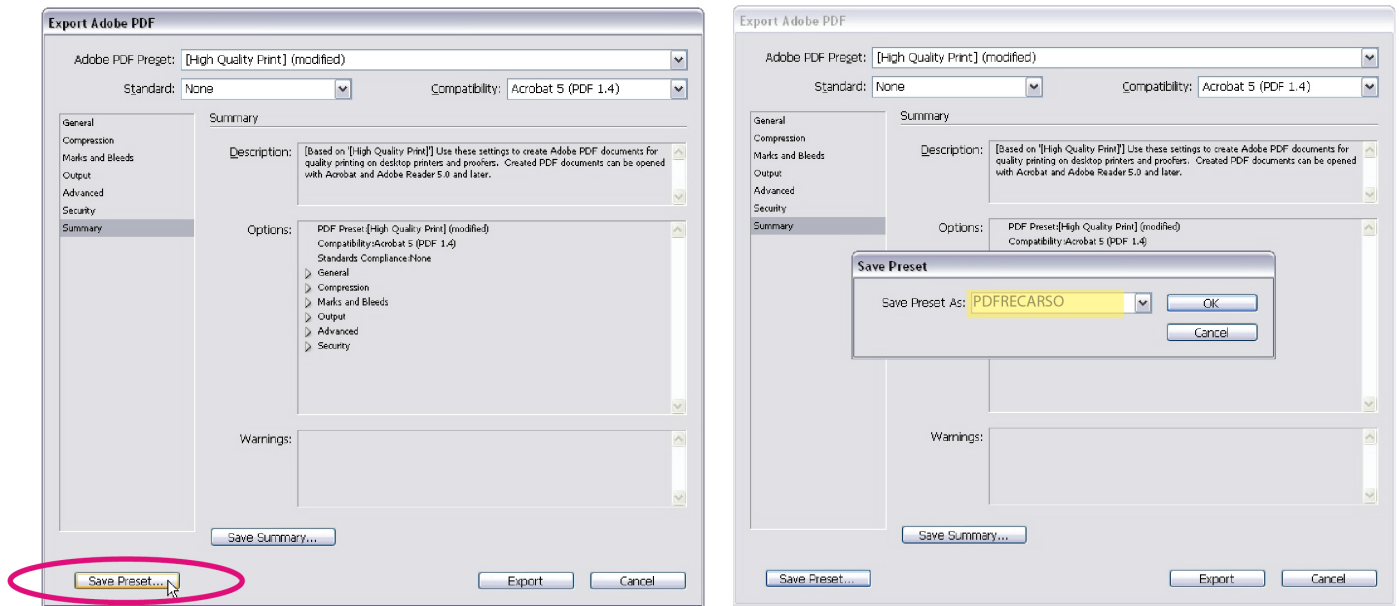
It is important that Transparency Flattener is set to 'High Resolution' so that after exporting, your artwork will remain in high resolution.

Step 09 - Saving PDF Preset

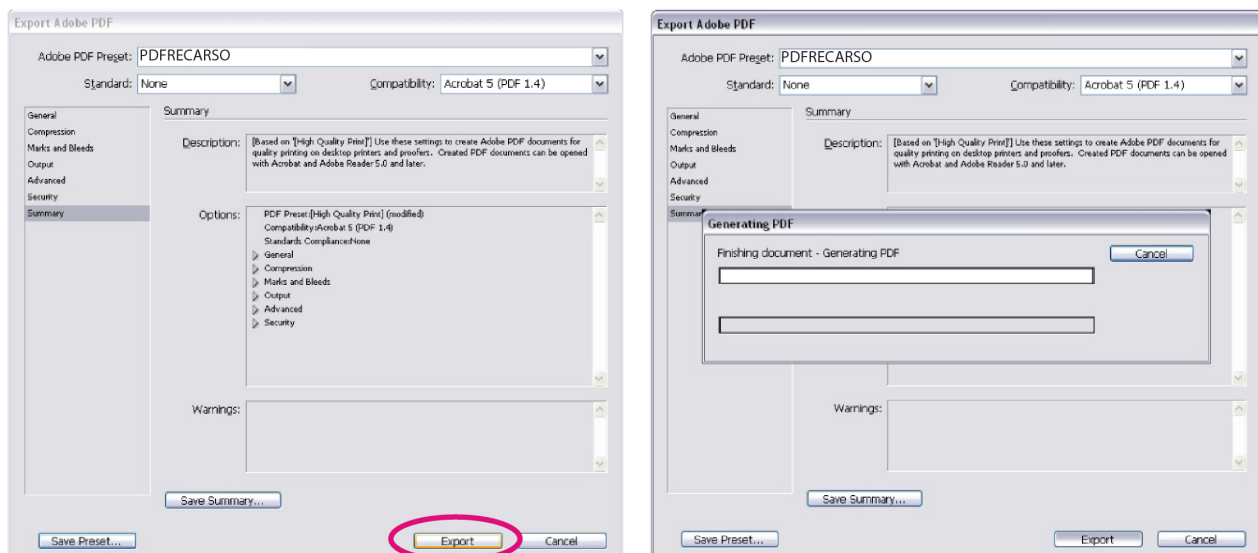


Go to Summary to review all your settings

If all are correct click Save Preset

At Save Preset As > type 'PDFRECARSO' or your preferred name

Step 10 - Exporting Your File

Why saving PDF setting?

Every time when saving your final artwork in PDF format, you do not need to go through the setting process again, just choose 'PDFRECARSO' as your PDF Style, and your document should be ready for upload.
